HEMU-SENU

42 Ntorotu/Ntorou (Deities) - Assessors of Maat

6-Week Online Course



HEMU-SENU means '42'. There are 42 Ntorotu/Ntorou (Goddesses and Gods), Divine Spirit-Forces in Creation, who are Assessors of Maat. It is these Deities who we ritually invoke on a daily basis and also after transition to assess our spiritual alignment. It is critical to understand that the 42 Enunciations of Maat, often called 42 'Negative Confessions' or 42 Laws of Maat, are actually ritual invocations to these 42 Ntorotu/Ntorou. These are not simply 'commandments'.

In our six week course we examine the nature and function of each one of these 42 Ntorotu/Ntorou (Netertu/Neteru). These Deities shown in the papyrus below are called Abosom in Akan, Orisha in Yoruba and Vodou in Ewe and Fon. We identify their shrines in our bodies and examine how we align with them ritually on Earth so

that we may also be in alignment with them after transition to open the way to the realm of the Aakhutu/Aakhu, our Spiritually Cultivated Ancestresses and Ancestors. Our course is based upon our book KOKOBO.
